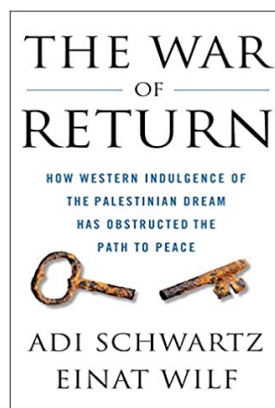
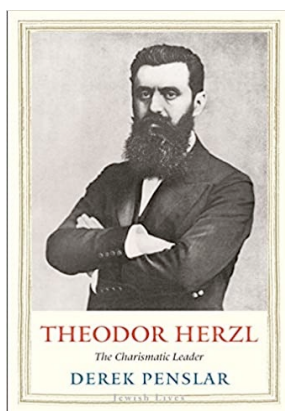
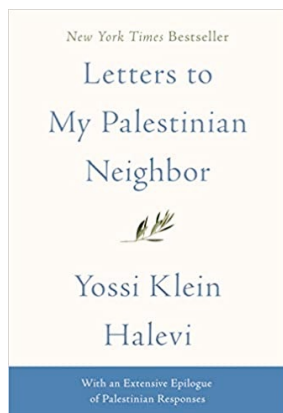


The Israel Bookshelf

Tues., July 28: Yossi Klein Halevi, *Letters to My Palestinian Neighbor* (Harper, 2019, with epilogue). The author, one of the most thoughtful and articulate observers of Israel, addresses Palestinians to lay out a claim to a two-state solution.

Wed., August 26: Derek Penslar, *Theodor Herzl* (Yale, 2020). The most recent and highly engrossing biography of the man considered to be the founder of modern Zionism.

Wed., September 30: Adi Schwartz and Einat Wilf, *The War of Return* (All Points, 2020). The book examines the issue of Palestinian claim to right of return and how it has harmed the peace process.

Wed., November 18: Kenneth Stern, *The Conflict Over the Conflict* (New Jewish Press, 2020). A thorough-going analysis of the Israel/Palestine debate on college campuses. (Author appearance scheduled)
